



## Privacy statement/CCTV

We take the protection of your personal data seriously. We process them exclusively on the basis of the relevant statutory provisions (e.g. DSGVO, DSG 2000). In the following you will find information on the most important aspects of data processing in the context of video monitoring (CCTV).

### CCTV

For security purposes, specified freely accessible areas in the Internationales Studentenhaus are monitored with a digital video system 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

### Purpose

This measure is for the purpose of self-protection (protection of property, employees, residents and their guests) and to prevent, curb and investigate criminal behaviour within the scope of the controller's responsibilities. The recorded data will only be evaluated in the event of an incident at the request of the Austrian police authorities.

### Data categories

Image processing involves the following personal data:

- Image data of the persons concerned
- Time and place of the recording
- Identity of the persons concerned

### Data erasure

Personal data will be deleted after 72 hours unless there is a reason for keeping them that is relevant in criminal law. In such a case, any data relevant for prosecution or law enforcement will be stored for the duration of the proceedings.

### Contract processors

We also remain responsible for the protection of your data when the services of a data processing contractor are employed.

Contract processors outside of the European Union will only be employed if an Appropriateness Decision has been granted by the European Commission for the country involved or if suitable guarantees or binding internal data protection regulations are in place with the contract processor.

### Data transfer

CCTV recordings may be passed on to the competent courts (preservation of evidence), competent authorities or law enforcement agencies, to the management of the Internationales Studentenhaus or to contract processors.

In the context of law enforcement, image data may also be passed on to witnesses, victims, insurance companies (to process insurance claims), lawyers or other bodies. No data will be passed on to recipients who use them for their own purposes.

### **Your rights**

You are guaranteed the rights of information, correction, deletion, limitation, cancellation and objection. The right of data portability is not guaranteed.

If you believe that the processing of your data violates data protection law or that your rights under data protection law have been infringed in any other way, you may complain to the supervisory authority. In Austria, that is the Data Protection Authority (Datenschutzbehörde) in Vienna.

### **Confirmation of identity**

### **Excessive assertion of rights**

Should you exercise any of the above rights particularly frequently or make a manifestly unfounded claim, we are entitled to charge an appropriate processing fee or to refuse to process the claim.

### **Duty of cooperation**

In keeping with our legal duty of cooperation, we are obliged to surrender data upon request in accordance with the statutory provisions (Code of Civil Procedure, Code of Criminal Procedure, etc).

### **Duration**

This privacy statement is valid from 25 May 2018 and replaces our previous privacy policy.
